## Psalm 1

### The Way of the Righteous and the Wicked

- 1** Blessed is the man  
who walks not in the counsel of the wicked,  
nor stands in the way of sinners,  
nor sits in the seat of scoffers;  
**2** but his delight is in the law of the LORD,  
and on his law he meditates day and night.  
**3** He is like a tree  
planted by streams of water  
that yields its fruit in its season,  
and its leaf does not wither.  
In all that he does, he prospers.  
**4** The wicked are not so,  
but are like chaff that the wind drives away.  
**5** Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment,  
nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous;  
**6** for the LORD knows the way of the righteous,  
but the way of the wicked will perish.

## Psalm 4

### Answer Me When I Call

To the choirmaster: with stringed instruments. A Psalm of David.

- 4** Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness!  
You have given me relief when I was in distress.  
Be gracious to me and hear my prayer!  
**2** O men, how long shall my honor be turned into shame?  
How long will you love vain words and seek after lies? *Selah*  
**3** But know that the LORD has set apart the godly for himself;  
the LORD hears when I call to him.  
**4** Be angry, and do not sin;  
ponder in your own hearts on your beds, and be silent. *Selah*  
**5** Offer right sacrifices,  
and put your trust in the LORD.  
**6** There are many who say, "Who will show us some good?  
Lift up the light of your face upon us, O LORD!"  
**7** You have put more joy in my heart  
than they have when their grain and wine abound.  
**8** In peace I will both lie down and sleep;  
for you alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety.
